5 problems with “putting out a fleece” to determine God’s will

Problem #1    Gideon already knew God’s will.

Problem #2    The fleece was associated with a miracle.

Problem #3    The fleece was an evidence of doubt not faith.

Problem #4    Putting out a fleece is dictating to God.

Problem #5    Fleece setting doesn’t really solve the problem.

2. Prayer and Bible Study (Psalms 119:105)
3. Personal desire (Psalm 37:4; 145:9; Nehemiah 2:12)
4. Providence (Acts 16:6-10)
5. Pursue wise counsel (Proverbs 11:14; 15:22; 24:6)
